

CONDITIONS

Women Elite and U21 Elite are held as a cup tournament. In Men's Elite the 20 topseeded players are directly in the cup-tournament – the rest plays qualification in groups of 3 players Friday, September 23 in Grøndal MultiCenter.

All other events are played in groups of 3-5 players and the 2 best players reach the playoff. U12-Starter will be played with consolidation.

Participants may attend one event per block (except CPH PING PONG OPEN). Players must participate in the event that they belong (level and age) to be able to play in other events, eg. a 14 year old player cannot participate in Junior events, if he/she does not also take part in the Cadet event. This is to ensure a high quality / standard in all events. Youth players can not participate in Class 3-5.

Please note there will be background music and commentator speaking during these events.

Ranking will be set up according to the World and Danish rating list and in cooperation with the Danish Table Tennis Association (DBTU). The Danish rating list of September 15 is critical for the participation in the ranks. All events will be filled up according of the most rating points. Ranking takes place in all events based on the update of the ranking list September 15 (Men's Elite) and September 22 (other events).

Enrollment for all events must be made within 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.

The tournament is sanctioned by the Danish table Tennis association (DBTU).

About CPH PING PONG OPEN

The Ping Pong Open is open to anyone. Players can join multiple groups during Saturday. The Ping Pong Open is played with a sandpaper paddle and according to special rules:

The game is played best of three sets up to 15 points. Each player may only once in each match go after "double points". It must be called before the ball is played and it can only happen in own service and latest at the server's 12th point. If the ball is won, it gives 2 points to the server. If it is dropped the ball the opponent gets only one point. Each set is played to max. 15 points.

All group games are played on Saturday. Group winners are going to the cup, which will be held on Sunday The finals take place in the elite section. The winner will be rewarded DKR 1.000,-
